Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was established in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They began as a small machine shop initially employing four individuals. Sales for their first year of operation amounted to about \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. Throughout 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to 40 staff and their annual sales volume had risen to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. At present, Cascade is among the top worldwide manufacturers within the material handling business.

Manufacture and design of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of new business possibilities. During the past sixty years, the material handling industry has matured into a highly sophisticated area and Cascade has proudly performed a part on this improvement. Cascade presently continues to grow as the premier supplier of lift truck accessories and various associated products. The business feels certain in their potential so as to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive in the international market.

In the 1950's, Cascade began designing, fabricating and selling hydraulic accessories. Construction was done in 1956 on a brand new office so as to accommodate all the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present center of operations. Following 15 years of business, total staff reached 180 staff and sales had reached practically two million three hundred thousand dollars.

The next manufacturing plant was built in 1959 in Springfield, Torrance. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary move into the global world of the material handling industry while the company recognized interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

The business altered its name to Cascade Corporation in 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The business has expanded its production facilities throughout the U.S. with areas in Portland, Oregon, Springfield, Torrance, and Warner Robins, Georgia. Cascade merchandise are manufactured worldwide thanks to many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This facility is made to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to acquiring five companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international best in forks.
